Town Hall Meetings – Measure BB

The City of Seal Beach would like to invite Leisure World residents to join City officials to learn how Measure BB would affect Public Safety and essential services in Seal Beach.

To make Seal Beach more financially secure for the future, the City Council unanimously approved placing a sales tax measure – Measure BB – on the November ballot. If approved, Measure BB would increase the sales tax from 7.75% to 8.75%. Measure BB is not a tax on your home or property, groceries or prescription medications. All Measure BB funds would remain local. These local funds are protected by law from the State and cannot be taken by Sacramento.

Measure BB is a prudent and sober recognition of the City's current financial condition and the prospect that this condition can worsen without additional, stable sources of local revenue. We ask that Leisure World residents join us at a town hall meeting to learn more about the state of the city and to weigh the merits of Measure BB.

Both town hall meetings* will be held in Leisure World in Clubhouse 3 (1421 Northwood Road) on Wednesday, October 3rd at 10:00a.m. and Monday, October 29th at 6:00p.m.
