Annual Slurry Seal Project – College Park West, Hill, Cove & Bridgeport

The City of Seal Beach is pleased to announce the Annual Slurry Seal Project for the College Park West, Hill, Cove and Bridgeport neighborhoods. Slurry Seal is a protective coating that is placed on top of asphalt to extend the life of the pavement. At the July 23, 2018 City Council meeting, Council awarded a contract to Mission Paving & Sealing, Inc. to slurry seal various streets within the aforementioned neighborhoods. The following streets are scheduled to be slurry sealed:

This project is expected to start September 5, 2018 with initial prep work including crack sealing and asphalt patching. Street sweeping will be suspended from September 3rd to September 28th in the Hill and Bridgeport neighborhoods. Street sweeping will be suspended from September 3rd to September 10th in College Park West. Trash pick-up will remain on schedule. The City will work closely with its contractor to create as little inconvenience as possible by the work.

Please note parking arrangements ahead of time. **Parking will not be allowed on the street on the day the road is being crack sealed or slurry sealed.** You will need to park on an adjacent street when your road is being crack sealed or slurry sealed.
