



# Mark, seal, and sign your envelope

## 1. Mark your ballot

- Follow the directions on the ballot.

## 2. Seal your envelope

- Check that you have the return envelope with your name on it.
- Put your ballot into the envelope.
- Seal the envelope.

## 3. Sign the envelope

- Date and sign your name on the back of the envelope in ink.
- Print your name and voter registration address.

## 4. Options for returning your ballot

- Mail your ballot in the enclosed postage-paid envelope.
- Drop off your ballot at the Registrar of Voters' office, no later than Election Day, 8:00pm (polling place designated for drop off only).
- Drop off your ballot at Seal Beach City Hall, 211 8th Street, Seal Beach, on Election Day until 8:00pm (polling place designated for drop off only).

## Important additional info!

- If you make a mistake call 714-567-7600 before Election Day.
- Your ballot must be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than 3 days after the election.



# Tips for marking your mail ballot and keeping it private.

Use a blue or black pen. Do not use pencil!

Do not write or sign your name on the ballot.

No extra marks, please! No numbers, no drawings, and no initials.

Leave this box blank, unless you want to vote for a qualified write-in candidate.
