Work Furlough Guidelines and Restrictions

Work furlough means that you will be enrolled in the Seal Beach P.D. Pay to Stay program and will be allowed to leave the facility for the sole purpose of attending work. The judge in your case has given you the opportunity to complete your commitment in this capacity.

In addition to the rules and parameters that were set up by the judge the following rules will apply to you and will be strictly enforced:

1. You will wear the ankle bracelet at all times during the duration of your confinement.
2. When you are released for work you are to travel directly to work.
3. You are to return directly back to the jail when your work time is over.
4. If you need to stop at the Seal Beach City Hall to make a payment on the way back to the jail, call first and advise the Detention Officer.
5. Travel to locations other than work or to a pre-arranged location is prohibited.
6. If you need to make any changes to the parameters and travel logistics set by the judge you MUST get the approval of the judge. This may require that you have your attorney go back to court and get a new order.
7. Violations of the parameters set by the judge will garner punishment up to and including the possibility of a reduction of good time / work time, loss of work privileges or dismissal from the program entirely. This may result in your immediate return to court or to the county jail.
8. If you need a special exemption for your time parameters (ie: late getting out from work etc.) you need to call the jail and advise the Detention Officer of same.
9. Make every attempt to arrive five to ten minutes prior to your check in time.
10. If the GPS tag vibrates or sounds an alarm, call the jail immediately.
11. Your GPS tag will need to be charged AT LEAST 45 minutes twice daily (once in the morning and once in the evening). If your job allows you to sit at a desk for an extended time, you may bring the charger to work. In this event charging the tag for an hour and a half will suffice.
12. You are to consume NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES whatsoever while you are incarcerated at the Seal Beach Detention Center or while released for your work.
13. You are to consume NO INTOXICATING substances other than prescribed medications given to you by a licensed physician that are approved by both the Detention Center Nurse and the Detention Services Coordinator.
14. Drive a vehicle only if licensed and insured.
15. Follow all of the conditions set for your probation.
