Construction Set to Begin On the Pier

SEAL BEACH, CA – The City of Seal Beach is pleased to announce that the Seal Beach Pier Improvement Project will formally commence on September 4th. The Project is expected to be completed by May 2019.

The construction work on the pier will replace aged and damaged utility lines, restore the pier for public use and access, and improve the structural support system so that infrastructure is in place should a determination be made for a potential tenant at the end of the pier.

The City awarded the construction contract to the John S. Meek Company Inc., one of the top marine construction contractors in Southern California with extensive experience in the construction and reconstruction of piers, wharfs, marinas and docks. The City of Seal Beach is excited to have a contractor on board with such an extensive work history coupled with a dedication to providing the best possible product in the most efficient and cost-effective manner to Seal Beach residents and visitors.

Construction will take place from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Night and Saturday work will only take place with advance written approval from City staff. The end of the pier will remain closed during construction. However, the majority of the pier and the pier playground (tot lot) will remain open during construction.

The bulk of the 10th Street Beach Parking Lot will be utilized to house construction equipment and materials. The 8th Street Beach Parking Lot will not be impacted by the Project and is available for visitors.
