A Message from the City Manager's Office

n November 6, 2018, voters in Seal Beach made their voices heard and overwhelmingly supported Measure BB, a ballot measure that increases the transaction and use tax (sales tax) from 7.75% to 8.75%. As of result of the measure passing, the City is estimated to generate approximately \$5 million in new sales tax annually, which will vastly increase the City's ability to remain fiscally healthy and limit the impact of adverse economic conditions in the future.

Voters understood that the State's continuing takeaway of local funds, the litany of unfunded mandates forced upon us by the State's legislature, declining revenues, and the increasing costs of doing business were at the root of the City's financial challenges. The voters also recognized that we could not simply cut our way out of a long-term structural deficit though services, and personnel was greatly reduced in order to maintain short-term fiscal solvency. Like many other municipalities across California who considered sales tax measures, the voters of Seal Beach acknowledged that the measure was an investment in their quality of life and checked the box that ensured that the services they have come to expect and enjoy would be intact for years to come and would not be taken away by the State.

While the City's finances have stagnated over the course of several years, City staff has performed admirably and continues to work at a commendable pace despite having fewer personnel and resources. They have worked harder and smarter and have demonstrated their commitment to providing quality service to the residents of Seal Beach. We will continue to do so and as we gradually become more financially strong, the services we provide will only improve.

The City Council should also be commended for their leadership and vision, as it was their unanimous endorsement of Measure BB that made certain the public would appreciate the urgency and need for taking the extraordinary step of placing a sales tax measure on the ballot. As representatives of the citizens of Seal Beach, the Council holds in high regard their fiduciary responsibilities, and as such fully backed a measure that they believed would set Seal Beach on a path towards fiscal recovery. The Council included provisions that would assure that Measure BB funds would be independently audited and that public safety, infrastructure, key services, and increasing reserves would be the primary use of new sales tax revenue.

Though funds from Measure BB will not begin to materialize until July, the City Council has already begun to act on the essence of the ballot measure by taking action at the December 10, 2018 City Council meeting, authorizing an increase in the Police Department's sworn Police Officer staffing level from 35 to 38 positions. The residents of Seal Beach desired, and were promised, more police officers if Measure BB were to pass. It did and now our neighborhoods will be safer as a result.

Over the course of the next few months, the Council, City staff, along with input from residents, will begin to draft next year's fiscal budget. We ask that you participate in the process by attending a budget workshop, speaking with your elected representative, or contacting City Hall to share your ideas. We also encourage you to visit the City's website at www.sealbeachca.gov to learn more about the budget process and ways in which you can contribute.

We look forward to a great Spring in Seal Beach!

Driver And Pedestrian Safety

The City would like to encourage drivers and pedestrians in school zones and at intersections throughout the City to do their part to further ensure the safety of drivers and pedestrians in Seal Beach.

The following are safety tips you can follow to be a responsible driver and pedestrian:



Driver Safety Near School Zones

- Set a good example by always buckling up and ensuring your passengers do the same, never using your cell phone while driving, and obeying all traffic laws and speed limits.
- Lower your speed and remain alert for pedestrians –
 25 mph is the maximum speed in and around school zones when children are present.
- Watch for and yield to pedestrians in crosswalks and at all intersections – they have the right-of-way at these locations.
- If a vehicle stops in front of you, slow down and stop. Do not try to go around – it may have stopped for pedestrians.
- Never pass a school bus while it is stopped with flashing lights and/or stop sign extended children are either entering or exiting. Failure to yield is a moving violation and subject to citation.
- Know and follow the specific drop-off and pick-up procedures established by your student's school.



Pedestrian Safety

Cross the street only at signalized or marked crosswalks, and always STOP, LOOK, and LISTEN...stop and then look left, right, and then left again, to check for traffic in all directions before stepping off

the curb. Keep looking for cars as you cross the street.

- Always make eye contact with drivers to make sure they can see you before crossing in front of them.
- Eliminate opportunities for distraction such as the use of cell phone, hand-held games, or music devices.
- Watch for cars backing out of parking spaces, or entering or exiting driveways and, never dart out in front of a parked car.

As an added safety measure for both pedestrians and drivers, the Seal Beach Police Department will conduct enhanced patrols at school zones and key City intersections to enforce traffic laws, including speeding, cell phone use, illegal parking, school bus passing, jaywalking, and non-seatbelt use.

COYOTE AWARENESS

The highly adaptable nature of coyotes allows them to live in almost any habitat in California, including in a surfside community like that of Seal Beach where natural space is part of the landscape and ample food, water and shelter is readily available.

If coyote sightings are common in your neighborhood or place of recreation, now is a good time to learn or re-familiarize yourself with the following simple strategies to safely and responsibly coexist with these wild members of the dog family:

- Make your property less hospitable for wild animals by removing shelter, water and food sources: thin ground level shrubbery that can serve as a den or hiding place, take down and store bird feeders, and promptly gather low-hanging fruit and collect any fallen pieces.
- Teach your children to learn how to identify a coyote and know what to do if they come in contact with one.





- **Keep a close watch on small pets**, feed them indoors, supervise them while they are outdoors, and always walk dogs on a leash.
- Store refuse containers in your garage or another ecure area until collection day.

Also of great importance is that you and your neighbors **do not intentionally feed or attempt to tame coyotes** as this causes them to lose their innate fear of humans, thereby increasing the potential for encounters and conflicts with people and pets.

In the event you encounter an aggressive or fearless coyote, the Department of Fish and Wildlife suggest you take the following steps:

- Make sure you are standing up and pick up any small pets or young children who may be with you.
- Face the coyote and try to frighten it away by shouting loudly and waving your arms above your head to appear larger and menacing; do not stop until it has left. If it does not leave or starts walking toward you, throw rocks, sticks or other objects in its direction.
- Retreat by walking backward so that you do not turn your back on the coyote.

Senior Dial-A-Ride Program in Seal Beach

Traditionally, the Dial-A-Ride component of the Senior Transportation Program has offered to deliver a senior resident to any location within the City Limits. Trips can be made for reasons such as doctor's appointments, retail/grocery shopping and dining excursions (within the City of Seal Beach). Trips may be scheduled for services within three miles outside the City Limits in Orange County for medical purposes only.

Recently, the Senior Transportation Program was assessed by City staff to identify opportunities to make the Program more cost effective while continuing to provide safe, reliable and user-friendly transportation services to participants. During the review process, staff learned that the County of Orange operates a program called Senior Non-Emergency Transportation (SNEMT) that is very similar to the City's Dial-A-Ride program. The SNEMT program provides seniors with access to non-emergency trips such as medical appointments, dentists, therapies, exercise programs, testing and other health related trips. The SNEMT program operates Monday through Saturday from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. To register for the County of Orange's SNEMT program please call Abrazar at (714) 891-9500.

As a result of staff's evaluation of the Program, the City Council adopted modifications to the Dial-A-Ride Program. The Dial-A-Ride Program will now operate from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Tuesday and Thursday travel will be eliminated. The modifications to the Dial-A-Ride Program will begin September 4, 2018. To schedule a Dial-A-Ride trip, please call (562) 439-3699 At least 24 hours in advance.

Shopper Shuttle

City staff also evaluated the City's Shopper Shuttle and transportation to the Senior Nutrition Program. Staff concluded that in order for the Senior Transportation Program to remain within budget and be available to a high volume of users, an emphasis should be placed on trips to medical facilities and nutrition programs. Assuch, no changes were recommended to the Nutrition Program transportation; however, the City Council directed staff to eliminate the Thursday Shopper Shuttle after December 31, 2018.

The Shopper Shuttle provides transportation to shopping centers throughout the

City of Seal Beach. The Shopper Shuttle runs in North Seal Beach Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. For more information and pickup locations, please call (562) 439-3699 or Public Works at (562) 431-2527 ext. 1317.
