On Tuesday, August 1, 2017, the efforts of thousands of other communities across the place at the Old Ranch Town country to promote safety, strengthen police-community partnership and rejuvenate community spirit by participating in the 34th Annual "National Night Out". This year's National Night Out provides an opportunity for the Seal Beach Police Department, in conjunction with the Los Alamitos Police Department, the Cypress Police Department, and our community partners, to enhance our crime prevention efforts by promoting cooperative relationships and reinforcing the need for community involvement.

The corporate partner for the City of Seal Beach will join National Night Out is "Target" and this year's event will take Center at 12300 Seal Beach Boulevard in the northern parking lot. Public Works Information

New Flag Pole at the Marina Community Center

As Public Works inspects flags weekly for any unusual wear or damage, the team found a damaged pulley on the flag pole at the Marina Community Center. Due to the difficulty of access, crews rented a specialized 80 foot telescoping lift to make the repair. Work was scheduled around summer programs at the center due to the safety concerns involved with the overhead work, and completed on time, before the start of the 9:00 a.m. activities. Flags are subject to UV damage and stresses from winds, while their cables and pulleys also require attention, making flag inspections a weekly task.





Concrete Repair in Alley Behind Ocean Avenue

The Streets Division recently repaired a concrete alley panel behind 401 Ocean Avenue. A small damaged section required a complete panel replacement to maintain the integrity of the existing pavement. Crews excavated, re-compacted, and then placed a large steel plate over the trench, allowing for traffic and access, while concrete was scheduled the following day. A high strength concrete was used to reach the desired strength and allow the alley to be opened up to full traffic as soon as possible.

Water Meter Box Replacements throughout the City

The City of Seal Beach Water Department has been in the process of changing water meter boxes due to cracked concrete boxes from trees and old age. In this process, we saw cut the old meter box out and replace with new meter box, meter lid, and new surrounding concrete to complete the job. This replacement process will enhance streets throughout the City.
