SERVICE ALERT: REPUBLIC SERVICES WASTE COLLECTION IMPACTED

SEAL BEACH, CA – Labor issues have led to delays in waste collection services for Republic Services customers. These issues will not impact Leisure World as they utilize a different waste hauler.

The following is a statement provided by Republic Services to the City: "Due to labor issues at Republic Services on Thursday, July 10, trash and recycling collection in Seal Beach has been delayed. Trash and recycling pickup scheduled for Thursday, July 10, will take place on Friday or later in the week. Residents in impacted areas are advised to leave trash carts out at the curb until they have been serviced. Republic Services will implement an accelerated recovery schedule that includes working through the weekend to catch up on any missed collections as quickly as possible. We are actively working to resolve this situation and to resume normal service as quickly as possible. Thank you for your patience and understanding."

On Friday, July 11, Republic Services will deliver a 40-yard roll off container to the City's Public Works Yard (1776 Adolfo Lopez Drive) to assist with the collection of Public Works trash and critical customers needing immediate unloading. Street sweeping services will try to circle back through areas missed by delayed trash collection. The Police Department is aware of street sweeping impacts and will adjust street sweeping enforcement in affected areas.
