OCEAN AVENUE CLOSURES PLANNED FOR SUMMER CONCERT SERIES BEGINNING JUNE 17

Seal Beach, CA – The Seal Beach Police Department is advising residents, visitors, and motorists of weekly traffic impacts associated with the Seal Beach Chamber of Commerce Summer Concert Series, which will take place every Wednesday evening from June 17 through August 12 at Eisenhower Park.

As part of a new event layout this year, Ocean Avenue will be closed between Main Street and 10th Street each Wednesday from 2:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. to accommodate vendors, and event operations. The closure area will include vendor booths and pedestrian gathering areas adjacent to Eisenhower Park. Attendees are not to be seated in the street.

Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead, use alternate routes, and expect increased pedestrian activity in the area during event hours.

To enhance safety and ensure a family-friendly environment, the Seal Beach Chamber of Commerce has agreed to several operational requirements, including:

- Continuous staffing at roadway barricades during closure hours
- Event staff monitoring the closure area and seating locations
- Four certified security officers assigned to each concert
- Enforcement of event rules, including no alcoholic beverages and maintaining clear sidewalks and pedestrian pathways
- Additional Seal Beach Police Department staffing for concerts anticipated to draw larger crowds, including July 8 and July 22

Temporary no-parking restrictions will be in effect within the closure area, and vehicles parked in posted locations may be subject to citation or towing.

The Seal Beach Police Department appreciates the community's patience and cooperation as the Chamber of Commerce hosts this annual summer event series. The goal of these traffic modifications is to provide a safe environment for residents and visitors while minimizing impacts to surrounding neighborhoods.
