SEAL BEACH MOTOR OFFICER INJURED DURING TRAFFIC COLLISION

Seal Beach, CA – A Seal Beach Police Department Motorcycle Officer was injured after being involved in a solo-vehicle traffic collision.

On Thursday, January 6, 2022, at about 4:30 pm, an on-duty Seal Beach Police Officer was riding his Department motorcycle and traveling northbound on Studebaker Road near the intersection with 2nd Street in the City of Long Beach. During that time, the motor officer was involved in a single vehicle traffic collision.

The officer sustained non-life-threatening injuries. The Long Beach Fire Department responded and transported the officer to a local hospital for evaluation.

The Long Beach Police Department is handling this investigation. The investigation is ongoing and the cause of the collision is not immediately known.
