Seal Beach Residents are Reminded to be Coyote Aware

Over the past several months, coyote sightings have become more common in cities surrounding Seal Beach. More recently, there were two reported attacks on humans in Irvine and a string of attacks on pets in Huntington Beach and Long Beach. It should be noted that statistics show attacks on humans are extremely rare.

Seal Beach has been fortunate to have a decline in coyote attacks and sightings in the same period. A large part of our success has been the result of residents taking the initiative to properly haze coyotes, safely securing pets, storing pet food indoors, and neighbors talking to each other about coyote activity in their area.

So how do we continue to keep coyotes from entering our neighborhoods? We need to eliminate the feeding of any wildlife whether intentionally or accidently. That means keeping trash cans secure and not leaving pet food outside. Coyotes are generally timid and shy animals that tend to steer clear of any potential danger and thus pose little threat to humans. If we can eliminate easy food sources, coyotes are less likely to be seen.

Residents with small pets (less than 20 pounds) should supervise them while outdoors. Domestic cats left outdoors can also serve to attract coyotes. It is important that domestic cats and small dogs be kept indoors. A coyote cannot tell the difference between a small cat or dog and a rabbit, mouse or any

other food source. Any dog that is left outside most of the time (especially small dogs) should also be watched with caution.

Always use a secure, sturdy leash when walking your dog. Retractable leashes are not recommended as they tend to jam and can make it difficult for you to protect your pet from a predator.

If you see a coyote during the daytime or are approached by a coyote, you should yell, wave your arms and/or throw something at it. Do not run as this will cause the coyote to pursue what it thinks is prey.

Water Conservation

The recent year's unrelenting droughts have led to a state wide need to conserve water. Potable water is not an unlimited resource. Despite the fact that a large portion of the globe is covered in water only a small portion is drinkable. There are countless reasons to conserve water, below are just a few ways you can help reduce the demand on the water supply.

Ways to save inside your home:

- Fix dripping facets.
- Turn off the water when brushing your teeth or shaving; this can save 6 liters of water per minute.
- Install a shut off valve in your shower.
- Run your washer and dishwasher only when they are full. You can save up to 1,000 gallons a month!
- Washing clothes in cold water actually save water and energy.
- Catch the water used while waiting for the shower to heat up in a bucket to water plants or dry stops on your lawn.
- Catch running water from faucet in a bucket while taking showers; excess water can be used to water plants.
- Place a cistern displacement device in your toilet cistern to reduce the volume of water used in each flush. You can get one of these from your water provider.

Ways to save outside your home:

- Get water catchment containers and have your rain gutters drain into them; use the water to water plants and lawns.
- ♦ Keep decorative fountains on a timer and have the water recirculating.
- Install water smart devices on your sprinkler system so it won't turn on if the grass is wet enough already.
- ♦ Keep your pool covered when not in use to reduce water loss due to evaporation.

Day to Day water saving:

- Don't order water at a restaurant unless you plan on drinking it, this also goes for refills. For every one glass of water ordered, 3 glasses of water are used: one to fill the glass, one of ice, and one to wash
- Report water waste to the appropriate party.







The Center is open Monday through Friday, 8 a.m.-2 p.m. Lunch is served at 11:15 a.m. For more information, please call (562) 430-6079 between the hours of 11 a.m. and 1p.m. If you need transportation to the senior lunch program, arrangements may be made with the City's Dial-A-Ride transportation company. This shuttle service is available to and from the North Seal Beach Senior Lunch Program site which is located in the Rossmoor Shopping Center.

Senior Dial-A-Ride Program in Seal Beach

The Dial-A-Ride component of the program has traditionally offered to deliver a senior resident to any location within the three miles outside City Limits. Dial-A-Ride service is available Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., and can be utilized by calling (562) 439-3699 at least 24 hours in advance to schedule a date, time, and location. The service can be made for any reason such as doctor's appointments, retail/grocery shopping (within the City of Seal Beach), and dining excursions (within the City of Seal Beach).

Attention Leisure World Residents: The City's Dial-A-Ride Program will no longer allow users to make reservations for trips that begin at a user's home in Leisure World to another location inside Leisure World. Leisure World currently operates a shuttle service that transports residents throughout Leisure World.

Home Delivered Meals

For homebound individuals 60+ years of ages who are unable to shop/and or prepare meals for themselves, Community Senior Serv delivers three meals directly to their homes – a cold lunch, a frozen dinner, and breakfast items. These meals, which provide 100 percent of the U.S. Nutritional Recommended Dietary Allowance, are available five days per week. Suggested donation is \$4.50/day.
