PRESS RELEASE Person of Interest Sought

SEAL BEACH, CA:

On April 25, 2019 at about 5:20 PM, the Seal Beach Police Department received a call of a vehicle burglary which occurred in the parking lot of the Chico's clothing store located at 12217 Seal Beach Boulevard. Just prior to the vehicle burglary, the victim left a nearby Wells Fargo bank after withdrawing valuables from a safety deposit box. The victim then parked her car in the Chico's parking lot and went in to shop. When she returned to her vehicle, she discovered it had been broken into and her property was gone.

During the investigation, detectives discovered that the female pictured below entered the Wells Fargo bank prior to the burglary. The female conducted no business inside the branch and immediately followed the victim out of the building after she withdrew the valuables.


Although investigators are unable to definitively determine if the female is a suspect in the case, they believe that she may have witnessed the crime or be able to provide information. Her identity is unknown.
