

SENIOR TRANSPORTATION SHUTTLE

The Senior Shuttle Service is a free 20-passenger shuttle that runs on a fixed route throughout major City stops, including Seal Beach Pier/Old Town area, Leisure World, and Rossmoor Shopping Center/ North Seal Beach Community Center. This Shuttle can accommodate wheel chairs and scooters, and has a bike rack that can hold 2 bikes.



How to Register:

To register, please submit the following to Anthony (via email or in-person/mail):

- An application (by contacting Anthony or found on www.sealbeachca.gov/Departments/Community-Services-Recreation/Senior-Services
- Photo ID showing proof of Seal Beach residency and date of birth. (CA driver's license or a Golden Rain Foundation ID card for Leisure World residents)

To use this free shuttle, you must:

- Be a Seal Beach Resident
- Be 60+ years
- Be Pre-registered with the City of Seal Beach
- Have your SMP ID Number available for the driver. (This
 is assigned upon registration. Expect a turnaround time
 of 3 business days after submittal of application)

Senior Transportation Shuttle FAQ

Is 4p.m. the last pick up or when the service ends?

Service ends at 4pm, making the 3pm loop the last loop. Make sure to plan accordingly. (i.e. if going to ralph's and need a return trip, plan on being at the Ralph's pick-up location no later than 3:40 PM for the last trip going back.

Can I wave the shuttle down if I'm not at a designated pick-up/drop-off location?

No, the shuttle will only stop at the designated location so please plan accordingly.

Do I need to wear a mask/face covering on the shuttle?

Yes. The current CA Guidelines require that all users wear masks/face coverings on all transit services.

What if I miss the last pick up?

The shuttle service is done at 4pm, so you may need to find an alternate ride home if the shuttle is missed.

Why can't the shuttle take me to Trader Joe's?

Trader Joe's is outside of the City Limits, and the shuttle can only go to the designated locations in the City.

Can my caregiver ride along? Yes, each registered user can bring 1 caregiver.

Is Target an official stop at the Shops of Rossmoor? Yes, it is! Riders can be picked up and dropped off at Target.

When can I expect the shuttle at the Shops at Rossmoor?

The listed time on the schedule is the when the shuttle is expected to be at <u>Ralph's</u> (the 1st of 4 stops), and riders can expect the shuttle at the other stops a few minutes after the scheduled time.

When can I expect the shuttle in Leisure World?

The listed time on the schedule is the when the shuttle is expected to be at <u>St. Andrews Gate</u> (the 1st of 4 stops) and riders can expect the shuttle at the other stops a few minutes after the scheduled time.

Hours of Operation: Monday - Friday, 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM

The Senior Transportation Shuttle runs each day from 9am to 4pm. Each day begins and ends at Leisure World. All of the times listed below are approximate. There will be no rides from 12pm to 1pm for the lunch break. The shuttle will finish driving to all designated stops in Leisure World at both 12pm & 4pm to drop off riders only.
