

Senior Transportation Shuttle

The Senior Transportation Shuttle Service is a free 20-passenger shuttle that runs on a fixed route throughout major City stops, including: the Seal Beach Pier, Leisure World, the Rossmoor Shopping Center, & the North Seal Beach Community Center. This Shuttle can accommodate wheelchairs, scooters, and has a bike rack that can hold two (2) bikes.



How to Register:

To register, please submit the following to Erika Halberg via email, in-person, or mail:

- Submit an application— found online at www.sealbeachca.gov or in-person at City Hall
- Submit a Photo ID showing proof of Seal Beach residency and date of birth. Examples include a California Driver's License or a Golden Rain Foundation ID Card (for Leisure world residents only)

Shuttle Requirements:

- Must be a Seal Beach resident
- Be 60+ years old
- Be pre-registered with the City of Seal Beach
- Have your SMP ID Number available for the driver. This
 ID number is assigned upon registration by City staff.

Senior Transportation Shuttle FAQ

Is 4:00pm the last pick up or when the service ends?

Service ends at 4:00pm, making the 3:00pm loop the last loop. Make sure to plan accordingly.

Example: If you are going to Ralph's and need a return trip, plan on being at the Ralph's pick-up location no later than 3:40pm for the last trip going back.

Can I wave the shuttle down if I'm not at a designated pick-up/drop-off location?

No, the shuttle will only stop at the designated location so please plan accordingly.

What if I miss the last pick up?

The shuttle service is done at 4pm, so you may need to find an alternate ride home if the shuttle is missed.

Why can't the shuttle take me to a location outside of Seal Beach?

The shuttle can only go to the designated locations in the City.

Can my caregiver ride along?

Yes, each registered user can bring one (1) caregiver.

Is Target an official stop at the Shops of Rossmoor?

Yes, it is. Riders can be picked up and dropped off at Target.

When can I expect the shuttle at the Shops at Rossmoor?

The listed time on the schedule is the when the shuttle is expected to be at <u>Ralph's</u> (the first of four stops), and riders can expect the shuttle at the other stops a few minutes after the scheduled time.

When can I expect the shuttle in Leisure World?

The listed time on the schedule is the when the shuttle is expected to be at <u>St. Andrews Gate</u> (the 1st of 4 stops) and riders can expect the shuttle at the other stops a few minutes after the scheduled time.

Hours of Operation: Monday - Friday, 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM

The Senior Transportation Shuttle runs each day from 9am to 4pm. Each day begins and ends at Leisure World. All of the times listed below are approximate. There will be no rides from 12pm to 1pm for the lunch break. The shuttle will finish driving to all designated stops in Leisure World at both 12pm & 4pm to drop off riders only.
