THE CITY OF SEAL BEACH LAUNCHES ECO-FRIENDLY MICRO-TRANSIT IN OLD TOWN, BRIDGEPORT AND THE HILL

SEAL BEACH, CA – The City of Seal Beach is launching a new pilot Micro-Transit program that will be operated by Circuit and was made possible by the grant awarded to the City from the Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Review Committee (MSRC) 'Clean Transportation Funding' Program.

This program offers easy, eco-friendly transportation throughout the City and will commence from the beginning of May for a duration of one year. The pilot program service area will include Old Town, the Hill, and Bridgeport. To start, Circuit will operate four days a week and provide transportation to all local spots such as Main Street and the Pier.
